Pet Overpopulation - What Can We Do?

an you guess the leading cause of death for cats and dogs in the United States? *EUTHANASIA*, simply because there are not enough homes for all of them. We hear about dogs and cats needing homes day in and day out. Rescue groups and shelters are almost always full despite their efforts to find adopters. Therefore, homeless dogs and cats in animal shelters end up being euthanized when their time is up to create space for new intakes. Pet overpopulation is a serious problem in our country and Tulsa is no exception.



On an average day, Tulsa Animal Welfare (TAW) takes in about 20 – 40 animals. In 2017, TAW took in 8,819 dogs and cats and the live release rate was 65%. To develop and execute a community plan to increase the live release rate at TAW and provide comprehensive and sustainable services for the pets, Mayor G.T. Bynum announced that the city would join forces with the Humane Society of Tulsa and the Tulsa SPCA to form the Coalition for Tulsa Pets (coalitionfortulsapets.org) in November of 2018. This is a great first step for Tulsa, but it will take some time to be fully implemented. So, what can we do to take part in reducing pet overpopulation?

Spay/Neuter

Spaying/neutering is the surgical removal of organs essential to animal reproduction. The most important reason to spay or neuter your pet is to prevent unwanted litters that lead to pet overpopulation. Tulsa City Ordinance requires all dogs and cats over the age of six months to be spayed or neutered (certain exemptions are allowed by permit). In addition to saving lives, spaying and neutering can reduce unwanted behaviors (such as aggression, roaming, and marking) and minimize the risks of diseases associated with reproductive organs.

Adopt, Don't Shop

By adopting a pet from a rescue group or animal shelter instead of buying from a pet shop or breeder, you will free up space for another homeless animal at the rescue or shelter. If you have a specific breed in mind, reach out to a breed-specific rescue in your area.

Responsible Pet Ownership

Pets are often surrendered to animal shelters when their owners no longer want to keep their animals for various reasons. Pet ownership comes with many responsibilities and it is a lifetime commitment to your pet. Consider all the responsibilities and consequences of pet ownership before getting a pet.

Proper Identification

Be sure to properly identify your pets by microchipping (collars and tags often get lost), so if they get lost they will be returned to you immediately.

Spread the Word

Educate others about pet overpopulation and how to take part in solving the problem.

February is National Spay/Neuter Awareness Month

ebruary is nationally recognized as "Spay/Neuter Awareness Month." The purpose is to encourage people to have their pets sterilized before the spring and summer months when there is a rampant overproduction of puppies and kittens. During that time, most animal shelters experience an unmanageable increase in animal intake.

Spaying/neutering not only helps control the pet overpopulation problem, but also minimizes the risks of diseases associated with reproductive organs such as testicular cancer or pyometra and reduces undesirable behavior such as roaming, spraying,

marking and mounting. If you have an unaltered pet, please act now! Contact your veterinarian to schedule an appointment or one of the following low-cost spay/neuter services (income verification may be required) in the Tulsa area.
