## Summer Tips For Your Pet's Safety

- 1) Always supply your pet with water and make sure the dish is out of the sun. Put ice in to keep it cooler, longer.
- 2) Take your dog swimming or hose them with water on hot days.
- 3) Walk dogs in the early morning or late hours of the day when the sun is least harsh. Carry water during these walks.
- 4) Check your pets for ticks and fleas. Purchase a pet-safe bug spray if they spend a great deal of time outdoors.
- 5) Don't take your pets to crowded summer events. "I can never comprehend why people insist on having their dogs with them at events such as parades and carnivals," said Wisconsin veterinarian Dr. T.J. Dunn. "Dogs don't care about arts and crafts, parades or carnivals. So why subject the animals to the heat and excitement of these human activities?"
- 6) Walk your dog on grass or dirt to avoid burning their paws on hot pavement.
- 7) Groom your pet properly and ensure they are free of mats. Cats require brushing in order to better regulate their temperature.
- 8) Provide access to shade at all times.
- 9) Sunscreen can be used on pets depending on the location of the sensitive skin. Use care in picking the product as cats and dogs are prone to licking themselves and should not ingest most lotions.
- 10) Above all, never leave your dog in the car, even with the windows open.

In February and again in March, Animal Aid of Tulsa teamed up with Wings of Rescue, an all volunteer organization, founded by volunteer pilots with a mission of flying at risk animals to no kill shelters throughout the US and Canada. Their vision is that all shelter animals will swiftly find loving forever homes. February 2016 was the maiden voyage from Oklahoma to the Pacific Northwest. Our very own Jethro, a coonhound who had been in our system for two years since he was found emaciated in January 2014, was lucky enough to be chosen! The pilot even chose him to fly co-pilot in the cockpit. Once in Seattle, WA, Jethro was adopted within a few days and now leads a happy and healthy life with his new owner. The beauty here is that he had been passed over for adoption for two years in our system, but in Seattle where the pet laws are strictly enforced, he was welcomed with open arms and hearts. We also sent seven on the March flight and they were all adopted within a week!! A big thank you to Kelly Brown, Rescue & Adoption Coordinator for making this possible!
