Cats can live long, healthy lives with FIV. A secondary illness or infection, not FIV itself, would be a cause of death.

FIV usually spreads from cat to cat via deep bites from an infected cat, or rarely, from an infected mother cat to kitten.

Outdoor cats, especially intact males who tend to get into fights over territory, are at highest risk.

Reduce your cat's FIV risk by ensuring all new cats coming in your household or spending time in your home (catsitting, etc.), have been tested and are FIV negative.

We always test for FIV before cats are made available for adoption; and, if FIV positive, we'll make that clear before adoption.

FIV affects cats only. It will not spread to humans or any other domestic species.

Call your vet if you suspect your cat has FIV, to double check that your cat has been tested, or if you have questions about FIV.

We're super excited about their new store at Eton Square and have already begun holding adoption events at their store. Stop in and say hello!








